

## WORLD OF WONDERS SUMMER SCIENCE CAMP

### Summer Camp Counselor

June 6th - July 31st

#### Main duties:

- Supervise campers during all camp activities/floor time/lunch time
- Wear a Green Shirt/Volunteer name badge provided by the Museum, return at the end of the day.
- Assist with check in and sign out of campers each day
- Assist with set up and clean up of all activities and experiments during the day
- Help facilitate the activities by helping campers with directions and procedures
- Help prepare daily lunch (Main Camp)
- Assist with cleaning/sanitation of Main Floor
- 20 minute meetings at the end of First Day and end of the Last Day to show progress(each camp).
- Facilitate a great WOW Science Camp experience for all staff and campers
- OPTIONAL: All counselors will have the opportunity to lead one or more of the scheduled activities should they choose, lesson plans or an outline of the topic and activity, and supplies will be provided for you. This is a great opportunity to lead a group so everyone is encouraged to choose at least one activity that interests you!

It is very important that all counselors understand their duties and their time commitment to the camp.

**Main Camp** starts promptly at 8am and ends at 4pm. Counselors need to arrive at 7:30-8:00am and be prepared to stay to set up the next day's activities until 1:30 each afternoon, although you are more than welcome to stay longer if there is more set up to be done. Every day allows for a 30 minute lunch break at the same time the campers have their lunch and a 15 minute break separately throughout the day. **(Those who do not receive their lunch break will be switched out once others come back.)** If you leave the museum during that time it is very important that you are back at the end of that lunch break.

**Jr Camp** will be from 8am-11am, you can choose which week you would like to volunteer for. Please try to attend as many days as possible for that week. If you are going to be late or cannot attend a scheduled day please call the Volunteer Coordinator or Camp Leads as soon as possible or at the museum at 209-368-0969.

#### What to Bring:

- Excitement for the activities and the day! (this is most important)
- Your lunch. (for Main Camp)
- Water
- Change of clothes on Water Day

### **What to wear**

- Close toed shoes
- Shorts are ok as long as they are knee length
- No visible undergarments
- T shirt and comfortable pants/shorts for water day.
- Jeans
- WOW Green is always a good idea! ☺
